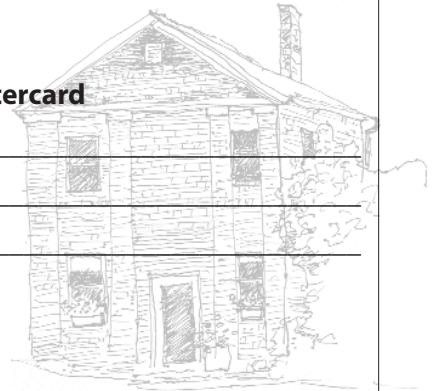

## What We Do

**Our Topsham Gallery** — Statewide arts nonprofit Maine Fiberarts is headquartered in an 1840's brick building in Midcoast Maine. See fiber artwork, meet artists, find event notices, and see photos of Maine studios and farms. Discover our gallery exhibitions, Tour Maps, and beautiful works of art and craft. Gain an insider's tips to cultural travels in Maine. Also, visit a working artist's studio upstairs and an occasional artist-in-residence in our Red Studio.

**Fiber Arts Mini Tour: Midcoast** — Our regionally-oriented printed (and online) Fiber Arts Mini Tour lists descriptive information for twenty select studios, farms, shops and galleries in Midcoast Maine. This Mini Tour is the first of what we hope will be a series guiding visitors throughout Maine.

**Fiber Friday** — On the First Friday of each month, from 10 a.m. to noon, we gather to stitch, share, exchange tips and treasures, and talk about good books, movies or exhibits we've seen. All are welcome! \$5 fee helps Maine Fiberarts keep on.



**Fiber Art Masters Book** — Our first published book entitled "Fiber Art Masters: A Visual Tour of Maine Artists' Work and Studios" features images and words by twenty Maine fiber artists. Pick up your copy at Maine Fiberarts or at shops statewide (call us): \$20 each plus tax and shipping.

**Fiber Arts** — include artists and craftspeople who spin, knit, weave, felt, bead, make paper, sculpt, design clothing, quilt and crochet; farmers who raise cashmere, wool, alpaca, mohair and llama; and the shops and galleries who bring work to the public. We use our in-house database and online Tour Map to recommend where to take a class, visit a studio, find a farm, or take in an exhibition.

**Maine Fiberarts Tour/Resource Guide** — located at [www.maineiberarts.org](http://www.maineiberarts.org), our Tour helps you find fiber studios, farms, galleries, spinneries, shops and manufacturers to help you plan your self-guided trip around Maine. Inclusion ON the map is free to all who work in fiber in Maine. Just fill out our online form.
